Course Description

In this new and revised Philosophy of Christian Education series (2023), multimedia segments and engagement activities present a foundation of teaching from an intentionally Christian perspective. Course 2 *Worldview*, the second of three courses in this series, defines and explores worldviews, explains a biblical worldview, and describes educational purposes from a biblical perspective.

Learning Objectives

By the end of this course, you will be able to:

- define worldview and demonstrate an understanding of how a worldview is developed.
- understand, articulate, and apply the core concepts of a biblical worldview.
- describe the purposes of education from a biblical perspective.

Course Requirements

- This full-length course requires a pre- and post-assessment, engagement activities, discussion forums, and formative assessments. All activities must be completed to receive credit for this course.
- The post-assessment for this course is an original composition, referred to as an "artifact," that showcases your personality as an educator and demonstrates your understanding of a Christian philosophy of education. Your artifact should meet the requirements detailed in the course rubric, but it may be in any format, such as a written paper, an audio recording, a video, a blog post, an infographic, a slide deck, etc. If you are applying for certification through ACSI, your administrator must review and approve your completed artifact.

Course Structure

This course is delivered entirely online though ACSI's online platform, <u>ACSI PD</u>. A subscription to the platform is required. All the lessons, course materials, and resources are provided through the platform. The course is asynchronous, so learners may advance at their own pace.

Committing 1–2 hours per week, learners can complete this 10-hour course in 8 weeks.
