1. Who was the author of this letter? List some key facts about the author.

*Jude (short for Judas) was a half brother of Jesus. Like James, he probably did not come to faith until after Jesus' resurrection.*

2. To whom was the letter written, and why?

*Jude does not specify his audience; he wrote to encourage his readers to "contend for the faith."*

3. When and where was the letter written?

*It was likely written near the same time as 2 Peter (around AD 65); we don't know where it was written from.*

4. What is the theme of the book of Jude?

*Contend for the faith.*

5. What other facts have you learned about this book?

*Answers will vary.*

6. Why is this book often studied with 2 Peter?

*Because there are some similarities between Jude and 2 Peter, some scholars believe that one author borrowed from the other.*
